** Let's focus on our E in RACES **

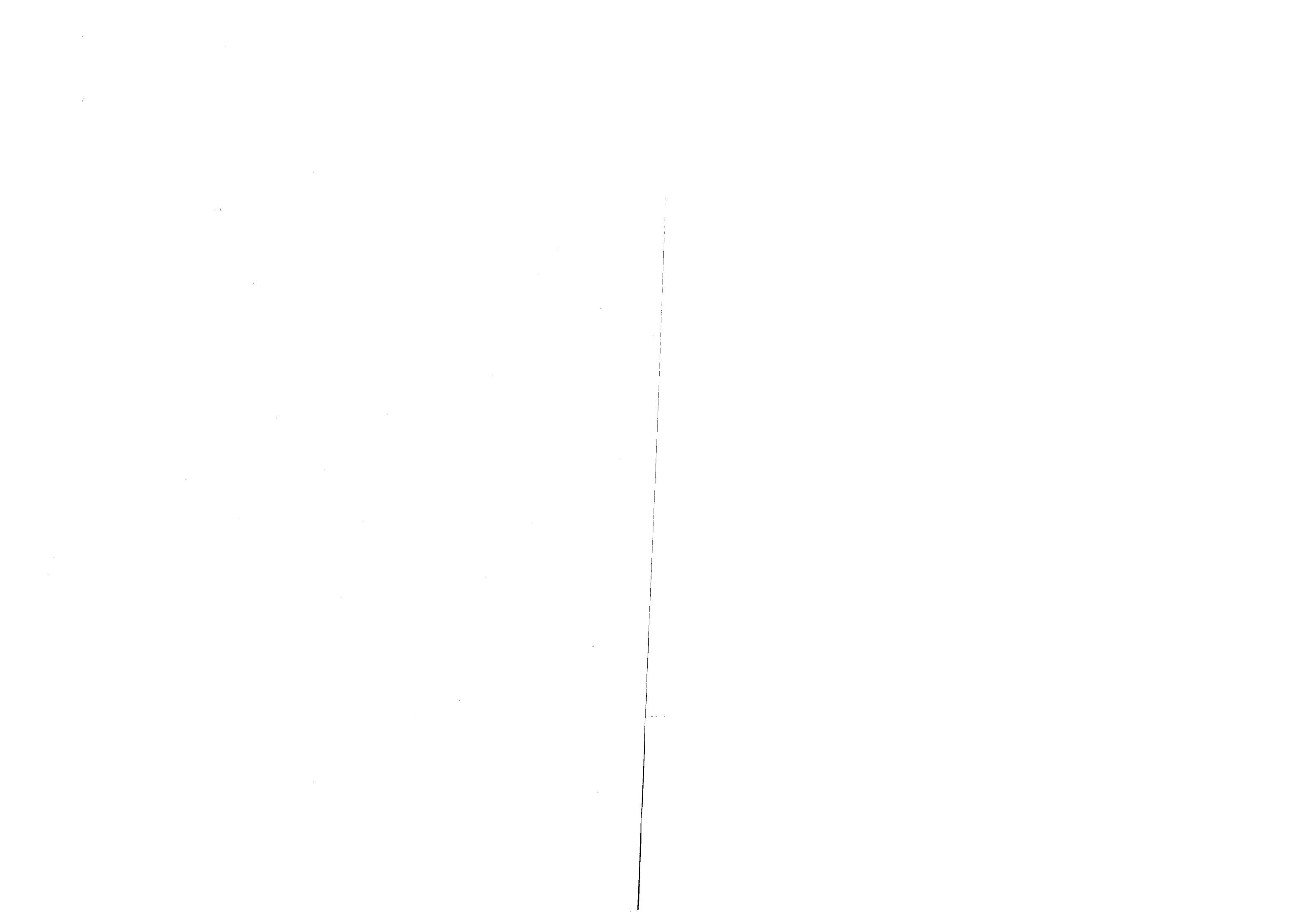
E stands for Explain OR Elaborate

In E, you should do ONE of the following:

- Explain how your quote in Citing your text evidence proves your Answer from above
- Explain how your quote and answer connect to each other
- Elaborate by giving more information related to your Answer and Citing

EXAMPLE of ELABORATING for E in RACES

Based on what I read, Via is foreshadowing that her and her friends could be growing apart. I know this because the text says, "This is why I haven't understood what's been going on with us lately, now that we're actually in high school, it's nothing like how I thought it would be." This supports my answer because she has been feeling more distant from Ella and Miranda as they move into high school. She was not expecting this to happen, because they have always been so close. In conclusion, Via is foreshadowing that her and her friends could be growing apart.
